



Summer dry... maintenance around the farm... more traction for utes and small trucks... Clic Wheel Systems Ltd has just the item for this season, says principal Andy Guet.

The company's SOK Clic dual wheel system, developed in Switzerland by GS Schaad, is the 'ultimate accessory for stability and go-power,' Guet says.

In the range are duals for heavier off-road vehicles, utilities and small trucks over three tonnes, with rims to 17 inches.

Marton spraying contractor Graham Greer, 25 years in the business, has used the SOK Clic duals for six months. With his partner Chris Wall he contract sprays over the greater Rangitikei area, working up to 50km from the home base.

'We do alot of broadacre spraying including weeds, grass and crops such as brassicas, maize and barley.'

They have a large self-propelled machine and a Toyota Land Cruiser doing about 4000ha per season.

'We fitted the SOK Clic duals last National Fieldays and they are a bloody good product.' He can now go almost anywhere on hillsides and gets more stability and safety.

The duals help to spread the load and reduce the ruts on softer ground and especially when travelling on new grass.

They are fitted only to the back wheels where there is extra load and the weight of the boom.

The duals are removed while travelling on the road, a simple job with three over-centre clips.
